Telemann, one of the most prolific composers of all time, was considered by his contemporaries to be one of the leading German composers of the time, remaining at the forefront of new musical ideas. The main piece of the day will be Overture-Suite in C major- Hamburger Ebb und Fluth (Wassermusik) TWV 55: C3. One of Telemann's finest overtures, this was composed in 1723 to celebrate the centenary of the founding of the Admiralty of Hamburg. The sea with its varying moods is portrayed in the overture, while dance movements in the suite are connected with marine mythological figures: Thetis, Neptune, the Naiads, Triton, Aeolus and Zephyr. Telemann displays all his talent for tone painting in this music. Alongside this, we shall work on the **Concerto in Bb TWV 54:B2**. Both works are for recorders, oboes, bassoons and strings.

We welcome **Philip Thorby**, who is well known as a performer, teacher and conductor of Renaissance and Baroque music. His energetic, passionate and scholarly direction is much sought-after both at playing days and longer courses. He is an extremely popular tutor at MEMF workshops.
