**Handel - Concerti Grossi Op 3** for oboes, bassoons and strings. Although much of Handel's music was vocal and choral, he was also prolific as a composer of concertos. His concerti grossi, inspired by the Italian Baroque composers - particularly Corelli, contrast solo groups of instruments (concertino) with tutti (ripieno) groups. Written in the 1730s, using mostly newly composed music, they are some of the best concerti of the period and never fail to inspire. We would like 2 oboes and 2 bassoons although Mozart recommends limiting the wind doubling to no more than 10 players per part!!

**David Hatcher** is well known to some of us from previous workshops and courses and is in great demand as a tutor. Born in Warwick, David was first drawn to Baroque music after hearing Handel's harpsichord suites during a family holiday. He studied recorder and viola da gamba at Trinity College of Music in London with Philip Thorby, among others. He is an exceptional performer on a wide range of early instruments and has played and recorded with numerous period ensembles both in this country and abroad. David says that although he has taught and performed a wide range of 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> century orchestral repertoire, it is always these Handel Concerti Grossi that show themselves to be outstanding masterpieces of the genre: endlessly inventive, innovative, startling and moving.

**Directions** to Dale Street Methodist Church CV32 5HL

From the M40 leave at J13 (from the south) or J14 (from the north), and follow signs for Leamington **A452** (NB not A425). Dale Street is the main **A452** through Leamington and coming up the hill from the south, the church is on the left just past the river – between Portland Place West and main crossroads of Dale Street and Regent Street. There are 2 small car parks at either side of the church and public car parks nearby:

**P6** Adelaide Bridge - CV32 5AH

**P3** St Peter's Multi Storey (access via Augusta Place) – CV32 5EL. Maximum charge in both is £4. Leamington Station is about 10 minutes walk away.
