Italian Masters of the Renaissance A workshop tutored by Philip Thorby for singers and instruments

Philip would like to tutor us on some of the wonderful multi-part music created in the Italian Renaissance. The programme will include movements from the 24 part mass by Annibale Padovano (1527-1575). The rest of the programme will depend on the resources we have available – if there are sufficient we might just tackle Striggio in 40 parts. This repertoire was part of the 1568 royal wedding celebrations in Munich, when Orlando Lassus directed a colourful ensemble of voices and instruments.

We need lots of singers (all voices, but there are LOTS of tenor parts), and instruments including cornetti, sackbuts, curtals, viols, recorders (players should bring tenors downwards, as well as smaller sizes), lutes and organ. Lassus chose eight large recorders, eight sackbuts, eight viols and a lute in his performance of the Striggio, and even more varied instruments in other pieces.

The David Turnbull Music School is a short walk beyond the car park, keeping the chapel and playing field to your right. There is an alternative entrance with further parking, from School Lane.
