At the heart of Christian worship is the Sacrament of the Eucharist. C16 composers wrote music of superlative quality to honour this sacrament. We will sing a selection of this music - including Motets by Tallis, Guerrero, Willaert, Byrd, Gabrieli and Josquin. Where else would you have the opportunity to sing such a wonderful selection of music in one day!

Our Tutor, David Allinson, is well known to many of us, and always a very popular tutor.... we have been waiting eagerly for his return to lead another workshop. David has directed numerous workshops and summer schools in UK and abroad. He has conducted the Renaissance Singers and has his own ensemble, *Cantores*. He is currently Director of Music at Canterbury Christchurch University, and prior to that was a Teaching Fellow at Bristol University. David studied music at St Peter's College, Oxford and University College, Durham and completed his PhD at Exeter University. The history and performance of Renaissance Choral Music has always been his specialism, so he is a perfect tutor for this workshop.

<u>Directions to St Faith and St Laurence.</u> The Church is situated at the corner of Croftdown Road and Balden Road. It is on a one way system (around a Pub!) There is some parking at the church itself, and also plenty of parking in Croftdown Road itself. Buses from City centre stop 5 minutes away in centre of Harborne. The Outer Circle bus (No:11) stops adjacent to the church.
